ROBLEMS OF STUDENT FAMILY IN MODERN SOCIO-CULTURAL CONDITIONS

Family is a complex socio-cultural phenomenon. It represents almost all aspects of human life and covers all levels of social practice: from the individual to the social and historical, from the material to the spiritual.

The article notes: firstly, the need for replenishment of the family budget and related need to work greatly distract married students from the main type of activity – education. Thus, financial difficulties do not contribute to the successful mastery of knowledge. Today, student family lives in very difficult financial conditions. Analysis of student families' budget showed that, despite some financial assistance of parents in a material respect they live in less favourable conditions than families of young people employed in production.

Secondly, one of the main issues faced by students entering into marriage is the housing problem. Hostels to some extent solve the problem of married students. Opportunity of a young family to get a room in a hostel directly depends on the financial support of a university. Only about half of universities provide such services.

Thirdly, a major problem for the stability and harmony of marriage to a young family is the relationship with parents. If a young family does not receive parental approval, it affects the inter-family and intra-family relationships. One more reason for the instability of marriage is misunderstanding between the spouses.

Thus, the state should support young families, including student. It is necessary to solve the housing problem, provide material assistance and create additional jobs for students.
