PHILOSOPHY OF COOPERATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY AND LOCAL SELF-GOVERNMENT IN THE CONTEXT OF SOCIO-POLITICAL INTERACTION

The paper aims to consider the problems of local self-government in civil society in the form of unity of interests of a single individual with the interests of society and the state; focus on the philosophical aspects of cooperation of civil society and local authorities in the context of social and political interaction in the interests of both the individual and society in general; analyze the specific self-government areas; summarize the social aspects of the relationship and mutual influence of civil society and local self-government.

In Ukraine, there are prerequisites for the further development of the institute of local

self-government and formation of civil society in Ukraine.
